GROSS: The specimen submitted is labeled as "lesion, right upper back" and consists of what grossly has the appearance of a thin skin ellipse measuring up to $2 \times .5$ cm. and overlying a cystic structure measuring up to $2 \times 1 \times 1$ cm. On section this is a cystic structure that contains cheesy yellowish—white material. This has the gross appearance of a epidermal inclusion cyst. A single representative section is submitted.

MICROSCOPIC: The slides contain sections of a piece of skin, and within the dermis is a cystic structure which is lined by keratinizing squamous epithelium and contains laminated keratinous debris. There is no malignancy seen.

DIAGNOSIS: Epidermal inclusion cyst.
